Tell Governor Henry you oppose his new "Tort Reform" plan to help the rich get richer.

1 Tell Governor Henry you oppose his Gov. Henry's plan takes away our constitutional right to have juries, our neighbors, decide what is a fair amount of compensation for paralysis, brain damage, loss of limbs or scarring (noneconomic damages) on a case-by-case basis. His plan would punish the most severely injured and discriminates against victims who are elderly, children or work-at-home mothers. It seems Gov. Henry doesn't trust Oklahomans as capable jurors.

2 Gov. Henry's plan would make it harder to hold Big Oil Companies accountable to mineral owners. Special rules limiting class actions and attorneys fees would make it harder to take unpaid royalty cases to jury trial. Further limits on punitive damages, already very restrictive, would allow Big Oil Companies to ignore their duty to treat mineral owners fairly. By pushing his new plan, which goes even further than the Republican Agenda, it seems Gov. Henry caved in to the wealthy special interest groups and giant corporations.

3 Gov. Henry's plan hijacks your right to access to the legal system. Under his plan, if you exercise your constitutional right to a jury trial and lose, the other side can seek to collect thousand of dollars in attorneys fees against you. This "loser pays" rule will close the courthouse to all but the very wealthy in our society.

Five facts you should know about so-called tort "reform"

1 "Jackpot justice" is a lie. Insurance companies and doctors claim victims "win the lottery" when a jury agrees they have been injured. The truth is, on average, insurance companies pay a victim of medical negligence less than \$30,000. Average payments have remained virtually flat for the last ten years.

2 Lawsuits are not to blame for your skyrocketing health-care costs. The fact is, last year, the number of lawsuits filed in Oklahoma and Tulsa counties decreased nearly 60%. If an increasing number of lawsuits is to blame for higher insurance premiums, wouldn't a decreasing number of lawsuits lower your insurance premium? The number of lawsuits filed decreased 60% last year. Did your insurance rate?

3 Healthcare providers must be held accountable. According to the National Academy of Sciences, up to 98,000 people are killed each year by medical errors in hospitals. You are more likely to be killed inside a hospital than in a car wreck or from cancer.

4 Doctors will not flee Oklahoma if tort reform isn't passed. Studies using U.S. Department of Justice statistics prove there is no correlation between where physicians decide to practice and state liability laws or insurance rates.

5 Lawyers are not filing more lawsuits than ever. According to the National Center for State Courts, medical malpractice filings per capita have actually decreased.

as a working person, in a wrongful death situation," Frasier said. "There are no economic damages, if there are no wages involved."

Frasier also pointed out how the proposal to cap attorney's fees will, in effect, limit average citizens' rights to seek justice in Oklahoma's civil courts. He noted that his law firm spent more than \$50,000 preparing a lengthy hospital negligence case that finally was settled out of court.

"I doubt that any attorney competent in medical negligence cases could have taken this individual's case, if Governor Henry's "tort reform" were in effect. It would not have made economic sense," Frasier said.

"Ultimately, this so-called 'tort reform' helps people who are well off and can show that they have suffered some loss of income or investment. Average folks are the ones who will lose their right to equal justice," Frasier said.

Oklahomans for Responsible Justice (ORJ) is a coalition of thousands of citizens throughout Oklahoma, working together to protect the fundamental freedoms on which America was founded.

Mrs. B.J. Kincade of Catoosa is the state chairperson of ORJ. She says "tort reform" is an assault on every Oklahoman's right to access the judicial system. She is staunchly opposed to tort reform legislation that would allow politicians to dictate a one-size-fits-all-verdict for every lawsuit in every courthouse throughout the state.

"If tort reform passes, facts and juries will become irrelevant because politicians will have already dictated your verdict," she says.

If it sounds like Mrs. Kincade is promoting a personal agenda, it's because she is. Mrs. Kincade's commitment to preserving your right to seek justice is horrifically personal.

On April 10, 1989, her son, Jim Hamby, burned to death after a side-impact collision in his 1984 Chevrolet pickup, which had the now infamous side-saddle gas tanks. The collision exploded the unprotected gas tank on impact. His truck went up in a ball of flame. Her son had no chance to get out.

Mrs. Kincade is now known throughout the country as a victim's advocate on auto safety issues. She has dedicated the nearly fifteen years since Jim's death to educating lawmakers and citizens about auto manufacturing safety and victims' rights. Through ORJ, she also is educating Oklahomans about the dangers of so-

called "tort reform" legislation.

"Bringing to justice one of the top three automakers in the world was like David fighting Goliath. But if these so-called 'tort

reform' laws had been on the books back then, fifteen years after the crash I still would not know what killed my son. I could not have held the company accountable, because I would never have known they killed him.

"Because I exercised my right to the justice system, we discovered, and eventually exposed, the company's deadly business practices. Our justice system forced them to produce a safer product. Our system undoubtedly saved lives,"

politicians believe they should have the power to decide verdicts, not jurors in a local courtroom. That's just bad policy. ■

Contact the Governor and Your Legislators Now

Governor Brad Henry, several Legislators, and a dubious alliance of business leaders are proposing sweeping changes to Oklahoma's legal system that will limit the average citizen's right to receive justice.

"The people of Oklahoma need join in a loud voice to oppose these proposals," said Jim Frasier, partner in Frasier, Frasier & Hickman LLP.

"It is absolutely imperative you contact the Governor and lawmakers. Let them know how you feel! They need to hear loud and clear that Oklahomans will not stand for a system that guarantees justice only to the favored few," Frasier said.

Under the guise of so-called tort "reform," wealthy interests in Oklahoma are trying to insulate themselves from any civil responsible for harming others who are less fortunate.

Henry has joined with Big Business interests to call for "Texas-style reforms" including capping non-economic damages.

"This proposition is an absolute insult and economic injustice to women," said Frasier. He pointed out that under the Governor's plan, capping "non-economic" civil damages discriminates against women.

"Under this kind of thinking, a stay-at-home mom or housewife is not worth as much

- Investment losses, not lawsuits or injury awards, have caused insurance premiums to increase.
- Punitive damages are awarded in only 3.3 percent of all suits for damages.
- Malpractice suits filed by patients against doctors has been decreasing yearly.
- Only 10% of medically injured Americans ever file for compensation. Only 2% sue. Fewer than 25% of those win.

LETTER WRITING TIPS

1. Address letter properly

2. Be Specific. When writing about legislation, use the bill number or the title if you know them. If not, briefly describe the issue that concerns you.

3. Be Timely. Write when the issue is current, not after a key vote has been taken.

4. Explain Your Position. In your own words, tell how the bill or amendment will affect you. Don't forget that a bill can change as it moves through the legislative process. So urge your legislator to oppose amendments which would weaken its purpose.

5. Ask for a Response. Urge your legislator to take action – support or oppose a bill, co-sponsor, offer an amendment or whatever action you would like taken. Request (don't demand) a reply to your letter.

6. Be Brief. Write about one bill or issue at a time. A one page letter is always the most effective.

7. Be Legible. If it is a hand-written letter, you might write a draft first and then make a second copy that is neater and shorter. Make it easy to read, whether hand-written or typed.

8. Be Polite. Don't be threatening, demanding or abusive. That's an immediate turnoff!

9. Don't be a Pen Pal! Write on selected important issues. Quality, not quantity, is what counts.

10. MAIL IT! Once you've taken the time to write a letter, don't forget to mail it right away.

Remember, the timeliness of your communication is as important as what you've written.

Legislators speak for you. You elected them so you should tell them what you think. Send them a message. Then the next time they vote, they can't say they didn't hear from you.
